

# ANTIQUE TRACTOR DISPLAY AND DEMONSTRATIONS

The Racine County Agricultural Society encourages the display and demonstration of tractors and implements made in the 1920's through the 1950's. In order to bring the experience of those bygone decades to the visitors of the fair, an area of the fairgrounds is reserved for the display and operation of antique farming equipment. A large tent is provided during the fair which may hold up to 60 antique tractors along with small engines.

The guidelines for displaying equipment are as follows:

1. Equipment will have been manufactured prior to 1960
  2. The tent is for the display of tractors and small engines that have been restored. The general term is "parade ready". A single exhibitor may have up to 2 tractors in the tent. Additional tractors may be displayed outside of the tent.
  3. Exhibitors must carry their own liability and property insurance on their equipment
  4. Steam powered equipment will have a current boiler certification and certificate of insurance on file at the fair office.
  5. Equipment must remain on display until 9:00 p.m. on Sunday, it is recommended that the equipment remain until Monday.
  6. Equipment must be in place by Tuesday night of fair week.
  7. Tractors not fitting in to the tent may be displayed outside of the tent. This also includes large equipment such as threshers, shellers, grinders, and saw mills. Owners of the larger equipment are encouraged to demonstrate their equipment for the public during the fair.
  8. There will be an antique tractor parade in front of the grandstand on Friday night of the fair at approximately 6:30 p.m. It is open to all owners of tractors on display.
  9. Each year, a different brand of tractor will be featured, This will be in cooperation with the Southeast Power and Collectible Society. The featured tractor will have priority placement in the tent. Other tractors will be grouped by manufacturer.
  10. Each exhibitor of tractors and large equipment will be granted one five day pass for each piece of equipment on display up to a **maximum** of two five day passes. The purpose of the passes is to allow the exhibitors to provide supervision for the display area, demonstrate their equipment and to be a resource for the fair visitors. In addition, each tractor owner is encouraged to participate in the tractor parade,
  11. Persons desiring to exhibit their tractor(s) at the fair may do one of the following:
    - a. Complete an entry form located below.
    - b. Contact the superintendent of the display area prior to the beginning of the fair.
- Fair passes will be distributed to exhibitors as their equipment is placed on display.
