- A. Livestock exhibitors are required to comply with all of the statutory and regulatory provisions of the State of Wisconsin relating to animal health. See the current animal health regulations in the front of this book.
- B. For base dates and class definitions see Section ATCP 160.08 of the Wisconsin Regulations in the front of this book.
- C. All goats must be permanently tattooed, ear tagged or micro-chipped. Copy of USDA Scrapie Letter and WLIC Premise ID must be available at check-in.
- D. Wood shavings are to be used for bedding. No straw will be allowed as a bedding alternative.
- E. All animals competing in the Open Class for premiums must be in place in their pens no later than 9:00 p.m. on Tuesday of Fair Week. Goats will be released at 7:00 p.m. on Sunday.
- F. No exhibitor will be awarded more than 1 premium in an individual more than one in a group class.
- G. Number of entries will be based upon availability in the barn. Pens will be assigned to each club or farm based on total entries.
- H. All animals shown in group classes must have been shown in their individual classes.
- I. Exhibitors are responsible for the cleanliness of their assigned pens.
- J. No equipment / stands / fans may be stored in the aisles. No electrical cords may be run across the aisles.
- K. Only animals entered in the fair may be housed in the Goat Barn.
- L. Animal(s) may be dismissed from the show ring at the judge's discretion. Premiums will not be awarded when the entry is not worthy, even though there be no competition. Judges shall be so instructed.
