

Hello Everyone,

PLEASE READ THIS LETTER CAREFULLY! THERE ARE MANY DIFFERENT THINGS FOR THIS YEAR'S RABBIT SHOW!

We are going to have a Junior Rabbit Show Only. No Open Class. NO Pet Class. We will NOT be doing Showmanship this year.

We will be having staggered judging this year. Please follow the judging schedule.

I have attached a showing schedule.

Before coming to the Fair Grounds you will need to do the following:

- Check over your rabbit. Do not bring it if it has any signs of illness, sores or nasal drainage.
- We will not be having a check in to check over your rabbit. If a rabbit is sick during the show it will be removed from the barn immediately.
- Write your exhibitor number in the RIGHT Ear. It can be found on your entry tag. If you do not have a Tattoo in the left ear please write your exhibitor number in both ears.
- Write your tattoo number on your exhibitor entry tag.
- There will not be any markers available at the fairgrounds.
- **For Auction Rabbits:** You will need to log back into the Fair entry program and upload a picture of you and your rabbit. Directions will be coming from the fair clerk.

Changes for this year

- Please enter through Gate 5 and park in the Case Lot. No parking on the grass
There will be signs posted.
- Please make sure you have your wristband to enter the grounds (Info from fair clerk coming)
- You may bring chairs and pop up tents to set up outside on the south end of the barn. (Where the campers usually park during fair.) You will not be allowed to sit in the barn.
- You will need your entry tags this year!
- You will not enter the barn until you are called.
- Please make sure you bring ice bottles for your rabbits incase the weather is hot.
- Youth will place their rabbits in the appropriately marked cages. (If you have a senior Doe you will place it in a Senior Doe Cage) They will be marked.
- Place your tag in the clear plastic envelop attached to the cage. Take the claim ticket
- Once you place your rabbit in the cage, please exit the Barn in the back (Follow the signs)
- The Superintendents will bring the rabbits to the judge.
- We will have someone filling out remark cards this year. Each rabbit will have a remark card.

- Once your breed is done being judged the Superintendents will notify you to remove your rabbit from the barn. You may take your plastic pocket folder with your ribbons in it.
- The Best of breed and Best opposite will remain in the Barn to the end of the day. (Make sure you water your rabbit.)
- The Best in Show will be picked at the end of the DAY. Approximately 3:30pm- 4:00 pm
You will be allowed to watch the Best of Breed judging. You and your parents only.
We ask that you stand on the marked X's on the floor and maintain Social Distancing. You may also wear a mask if you would like.

Auction Rabbits

We will have a Virtual Auction. It will be held Sunday August 2nd starting at 11am

You may want to send letters to area businesses inviting them to the Virtual Auction. They will want to check the Racine County Fair Website for the link to the Auction.

- On 7/29/20 your rabbits will be weighed. From 4-5:00 pm. (Following the Best of Breed judging.)
You will need to sign your Drug form as well as your parents. All rabbits that are not 4 pounds will not be allowed to auction.
- You will be able to sign up for a time to take your rabbit to the Processor.
- The cost for Processing is \$5.00 per Rabbit. You will pay the Processor directly.
- It will be your responsibility to pick up the rabbit and to deliver it to your Buyer.
- There will be address cards for the processor at the time of auction sign up.

If by chance your rabbit is not sold in the virtual auction you can keep your rabbit or donate it to Love Inc. You will need to take it to the processor as well.

Please Note: We thought this would be the best way to keep everyone safe and yet allow you to show your Rabbits. This has been a difficult year for everyone. We will try our best to stay on schedule. Please be patient.
