### PARTICIPATION / SAFETY

The International Demolition Derby is promoted as an unusual spectator attraction. In the interest of safety,
Drivers and Mechanics are subject to, and must obey, the following rules and regulations which are set up by the promoter
and the track where this event is being held.

- A. Each required driver must fill out an entry blank. All drivers must supply their own Garden Tractor, only one entry per person per class.
- B. All drivers 17 or younger years of age must have a notarized release signed by his or her parents or guardian.
- C. The track or promoter reserves the right to approve or reject any and all entries.
- D. All persons must sign the release sheet and receive a pit pass to be permitted in the pit area or on the track.
- E. No drinking of alcoholic beverages on track, emergency vehicle area or in the pit area. Any driver or pit person under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be immediately disqualified and removed from the grounds.
- F. Any driver or crew member disobeying the rules will cause his or her Garden Tractor to be disqualified. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and will be grounds for disqualification and barring from future derbies. Drivers are responsible for the actions of their crew members.
- G. International Demolition Derby will not be responsible for any damage caused by driver's negligence on the track or in the pit area.
- H. The promoter, track owner or fair association will not be held responsible for any Garden Tractor, parts or personal property before, during and after the show or overnight.
- I. Garden Tractor and driver must sign in at registration desk at least one hour prior to EARLIEST SHOW TIME or a \$25.00 fine may be imposed for late arrivals.
- J. Safety belt, DOT approved helmet, goggles, safety glasses or face shields are required.
- K. One minute limit is enforced by the track officials for re-starts and making competitive contact with another Garden Tractor. Hits must be aggressive.
- L. Track boundaries must be observed at all times. Any Garden Tractor shoved or driven out of bounds may be immediately disqualified if Derby officials feel it's a safety hazard.
- M. Driver must have long sleeve shirt and pants on at all times.

### TYPE OF GARDEN TRACTOR:

- 1. Only factory available front engine mounted Garden Tractors are allowed.
- 2. A maximum of 24 horsepower motors are allowed.
- 3. No zero turn Garden Tractors allowed

### PREPARATION OF GARDEN TRACTOR

(Remove the following before arriving at fairgrounds or track.)

- 1. Frame must be factory, no homemade frames.
- 2. Stock engines only. i.e.: Briggs, Stratton, Tecumseh, Kholer, etc.
- 3. No frame modifications except where specified.
- 4. Transaxle must be factory.
- 5. Engine protectors may be used, but cannot be outside of the hood.
- 6. Hoods must remain factory or made with same size sheet metal.
- 7. Additional screws, bolts or welding may be used to hold the hood in place.
- 8. Leaking gas may be cause for disqualifications.
- 9. Stock Garden Tractor type wheels/tires must be used. No dual wheels. No foam filled tires.
- 10. Mower decks must be removed.
- 11. All headlights and plastic must be removed.
- 12. All Garden Tractors must have some type of leg guards, i.e.: from boot rest/frame to rear fenders. Leg guards must be bolted, welded, or 9-wired. Leg protection must stay in place or you will be disqualified.
- 13. Garden Tractors must have a number on each side.
- 14. Front and rear bumpers are permitted. Bumpers must not cover more than 75% of the tires.
- 15. All metals added shall not have any sharp or puncture type ends.
- 16. Seat belts may be used.
- 17. In the event of a stalled engine the Garden Tractor must be able to restart with the Driver remaining in the seat. No leaning over the hood to restart the Garden Tractor.
- 18. Homemade exhausts are allowed. They must be pointed up or down.

Hits to another Tractor are to be with the front of your Tractor only.

No hits are allowed to the leg area of any Tractor.

Hits are to be to the wheels, front or rear of Tractor only.

Discretion is to be used for any hit.

Safety of the drivers is to be the main concern.

All repairs to Garden Tractor are to be done while on the seat of the Tractor.

No getting off of the Tractor for repairs.

No pushing off or kicking of opponent's tires is allowed.

If locked up with another Tractor, rocking of the Tractor is the only thing allowed.
