- A. All exhibits will be judged face-to-face, Monday of Fair, from noon to 7 p.m. with a break at 3:30 p.m. The Youth Building will be open at 11:00 a.m. Numbers will be available at 11:45 a.m. After judging is finished, the building will close. Judging will take place in the 4-H Youth Building.
- B. Projects entered at this year's Racine County 4-H Communications and Arts Festival (CPAF) may also be entered at this year's Racine County Fair. Entries from previous year's Communication and Arts Festival (CPAF) will not be accepted.
- C. Any paper item, including creative writing pieces, measuring 8 ½" x 11" or smaller must be in a protective plastic sleeve or folder.
- D. Posters or panels must not exceed 22" x 28" in size.
- E. Punch a hole in the upper right-hand corner of your project to affix the entry tag.
- F. A maximum of five (5) items / styles per exhibitor may be exhibited per division, but no more than one exhibitor per class number.
- G. Wi-Fi access will be available for judging; however, the exhibitor must supply a computer or tablet for viewing applicable entries.

## Division 1 - Spoken Word

- A. Speeches, demonstrations, and other verbal entries may be recorded **OR** live and **MUST INCLUDE A PHYSICAL EXHIBIT TO BE DISPLAYED AT THE FAIR** (poster, program, written summary, outline, notecards, photo montage). Plead consider the following time guidelines:
  - a. 3<sup>rd</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> Grade: 2-7 minutes
  - b. 5<sup>th</sup> 7<sup>th</sup> Grade: 4-9 minutes
  - c. 8th Grade and Older: 6-12 minutes
  - d. Team Demonstrations Time limit will be determined by the oldest participant
- B. Apart from dramatic readings, theatric / dramatic and musical entries will NOT be accepted. These exhibits should instead be entered in Dept 18 (Junior Class Cultural Arts & Crafts) under Divisions 9 (Drama) or 10 (Music)
