Youth Participant **MUST be present to win!**

Requirements:

This is a competition for amateurs. Commercial enterprises or businesses are not eligible to enter.

- Open to Youth ages 9-17. Adult mentors ages 18 years+
- Youth must plant, nurture and grow cabbage, with guidance and supervision from mentor.
- Cabbage can be grown from seed or plant. Starting seedlings in a greenhouse is acceptable but not required.
- Grow and exhibit 2 heads of cabbages any variety - round, pointed, red, green. Etc.
- Cabbage heads to be displayed in a container (i.e. basket, bucket, box, crate), with props (i.e. fabric, vegetables/fruits/flowers/herbs/decorations) be creative!
- Participant to provide a personally made 8.5 x 11 size portfolio with their container to include
 - Cabbage variety/varieties
 - Explanation of planting, growing and harvesting process
 - Use of pest prevention
 - One thing (skill) that youth learned from their mentor about the growing process
 - Include 4 photos of youth participating in the growing process
 - List itemized cost of all materials – must not exceed \$75.00

One entry will be selected as the contest winner.

Each cabbage head will be judged individually based on cabbage appearance, quality, size, firmness (cabbage heads will not be judged on uniformity due to 2 different varieties potentially being present in one container), followed by display creativity, presentation, overall appearance, and portfolio details and design.

Winner and/or mentor may not win contest two years in a row.

The decision of the judge(s) will be final.

Youth contest participant must be present at judging date, time, and location to win.

One \$1,000 cash prize provided by the Borzynski's Farms will be awarded in the form of a check solely payable to YOUTH contest winner and must be picked up at the Fair Office. Cash prize redemption requires completion of an IRS W-9 form by contest winner prior to cash prize distribution.

All entries must remain on display throughout the duration of the Racine County Fair and must be picked up on Monday after Racine County Fair, July 29, 2024, between 5:00 PM and 7:00 PM at the Open Class Building
